David: A Man After God's Own Heart! Unusual Suspects, Pt. 3 1 Samuel 13:14 Sunday, June 15, 2025

1 Samuel 13:14, "But now your kingdom will not endure; <u>the</u> <u>LORD has sought out a man after his own heart</u> and appointed him ruler of his people, because you have not kept the LORD'S command."

• Saul Looked the Part – David <u>LIVED</u> the Part

<u>1 Samuel 9:2</u>, Kish had a son named Saul, as handsome a young man as could be found anywhere in Israel, and he was a head taller than anyone else.

• Saul Had Potential – But Lacked FOLLOW-THROUGH

<u>1 Samuel 10:24</u>, Samuel said to all the people, "Do you see the man the LORD has chosen? There is no one like him among all the people."

<u>1 Samuel 13:13</u>, "You have done a foolish thing," Samuel said. "You have not kept the command the LORD your God gave you..."

Saul Feared People – David Feared <u>GOD</u>

<u>1 Samuel 15:24,</u> ... "I was afraid of the men and so I gave in to them."

Saul Built Monuments to Himself – David Built <u>ALTARS</u> to God

<u>1 Samuel 15:12, ...</u> "Saul has gone to Carmel. There he has set up a monument in his own honor..."

<u>2 Samuel 24:25</u>, David built an altar to the LORD there and sacrificed burnt offerings and fellowship offerings.

What Made David So Special? David Had...

1. A Heart That Chooses Faith Before the FIGHT

<u>1 Samuel 17:37</u>, "The LORD who rescued me from the paw of the lion and the paw of the bear will rescue me from the hand of this Philistine."

Proverbs 3:5, *Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;* **6** *in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.*

Psalm 20:7, Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God.

2. A Heart That Trusts God's TIMING

1 Samuel 24:6, He said to his men, "<u>The LORD forbid</u> <u>that I should do such a thing</u> to my master, the LORD'S anointed, or lay my hand on him; for he is the anointed of the LORD.'"

Isaiah 40:31, but those who <u>hope in the LORD will</u> <u>renew their strength</u>. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.

Psalm 27:14, Wait for the LORD; be strong and take <u>heart</u> and wait for the LORD.

3. A Heart That Steps Up When It COUNTS

2 Samuel 5:3, When all the elders of Israel had come to King David at Hebron, the king made a covenant with them at Hebron before the LORD, and <u>they anointed</u> David king over Israel. **4** David was thirty years old when he became king, and he reigned forty years.

Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? <u>Be strong</u> <u>and courageous</u>. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."

<u>**1 Corinthians 16:13,**</u> Be on your guard; <u>stand firm in</u> <u>the faith</u>; be courageous; be strong.

4. A Heart That Comes Clean and <u>COMES BACK</u>

<u>2 Samuel 12:13,</u> Then David said to Nathan, "<u>I have</u> <u>sinned against the LORD</u>." Nathan replied, "The LORD has taken away your sin. You are not going to die."

Psalm 51:10, Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

1 John 1:9, If we confess our sins, <u>he is faithful and just</u> <u>and will forgive us our sins</u> and purify us from all unrighteousness.

5. A Heart That Worships God Without HOLDING BACK

<u>2 Samuel 6:14,</u> Wearing a linen ephod, <u>David was</u> <u>dancing before the LORD with all his might</u>,

Romans 1:16, For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes...

John 4:24, "God is spirit, and his worshipers <u>must</u> worship in the Spirit and in truth."

6. A Heart for the Next GENERATION

<u>1 Chronicles 28:9</u>, "And you, my son Solomon, <u>acknowledge the God of your father, and serve him</u> <u>with wholehearted devotion and with a willing mind</u>, for the LORD searches every heart and understands every desire and every thought. If you seek him, he will be found by you; but if you forsake him, he will reject you forever. **10** Consider now, for the LORD has chosen you to build a house as the sanctuary. Be strong and do the work."

Deuteronomy 6:6, These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. **7** <u>Impress them on</u> <u>your children</u>. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road...

Psalm 145:4, <u>One generation commends your works to</u> <u>another</u>; they tell of your mighty acts.

7. A Heart That Stays Faithful to the FINAL BREATH

Acts 13:36, "Now when <u>David had served God's</u> <u>purpose in his own generation</u>, he fell asleep; he was buried with his ancestors and his body decayed."

<u>2 Timothy 4:7,</u> I have fought the good fight, <u>I have</u> finished the race, I have kept the faith.

Philippians 1:6, being confident of this, that <u>he who</u> began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.
