Luke 10:25, One day an expert in religious law stood up to test Jesus by asking him this question: "Teacher, what should I do to inherit eternal life?"

Luke 10:26, Jesus replied, "What does the law of Moses say? How do you read it?"

Luke 10:27, The man answered, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind'...

Luke 10:27, ... 'Love your neighbor as yourself."

Luke 10:28, "You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live."

Luke 10:29, But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"

Luke 10:30, In reply Jesus said: "A man was going down from Jerusalem to Jericho, when he was attacked by robbers...

Luke 10:30, ...They stripped him of his clothes, beat him and went away, leaving him half dead.

Luke 10:31, A priest happened to be going down the same road, and when he saw the man, he passed by on the other side.

Luke 10:32, So too, a Levite, when he came to the place and saw him, passed by on the other side.

Luke 10:33, But a Samaritan, as he traveled, came where the man was; and when he saw him, he took pity on him.

Luke 10:34, He went to him and bandaged his wounds, pouring on oil and wine...

Luke 10:35, The next day...

Luke 10:35, The next day he took out two denarii and gave them to the innkeeper. 'Look after him,' he said, 'and when I return, I will reimburse you for any extra expense you may have.'

Luke 10:36, "Which of these three do you think was a neighbor to the man who fell into the hands of robbers?"

Luke 10:37, ...The expert in the law replied, "The one who had mercy on him."

Luke 10:37, ... "Go and do likewise."
