## How Do We Stay Encouraged in Discouraging Times?

Unstoppable, Pt. 8 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18 March 3. 2024

1 Thessalonians 1:1, Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace and peace to you. 2 We always thank God for all of you and continually mention you in our prayers. 3 We remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ.

<u>1 Thessalonians 4:18</u>, Therefore <u>encourage</u> one another with these words.

Acts 1:9, After he said this, he was taken up before their very eyes, and a cloud hid him from their sight. 10 They were looking intently up into the sky as he was going, when suddenly two men dressed in white stood beside them. 11 "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

## How Do We Stay Encouraged in Discouraging Times?

### 1. Don't Ever Lose HOPE

1 Thessalonians 4:13, Brothers and sisters, we do not want you to be uninformed about those who sleep in death, so that you do not grieve like the rest of mankind, who have no hope.

Romans 15:13, May the <u>God of hope</u> fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

<u>2 Corinthians 5:8</u>, We are confident, I say, and would prefer to be away from the body and at home with the Lord. **9** So we make it our goal to please him, whether we are at home in the body or away from it.

#### 2. Don't Ever Lose FAITH

<u>1 Thessalonians 4:14</u>, For we <u>believe</u> that Jesus died and rose again, and so we <u>believe</u> that God will bring with Jesus those who have fallen asleep in him. **15** According to the Lord's word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are <u>left until the coming of the Lord</u>, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep.

John 14:1, "Do not let your hearts be troubled. You believe in God; believe also in me. 2 My Father's house has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you? 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.

## 3. Don't Ever Stop LISTENING

1 Thessalonians 4:16, For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a <u>loud command</u>, with the <u>voice of the archangel</u> and with the <u>trumpet call of God</u>, and the dead in Christ will rise first. 17 After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. <u>And so we will be with the Lord forever</u>.

1 Corinthians 15:51, Listen, I tell you a mystery; We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. 53 For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality. 54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory."

Romans 8:23, Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the firstfruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies.

# 4. Don't Ever Stop Encouraging OTHERS

<u>1 Thessalonians 4:18</u>, Therefore <u>encourage one another</u> with these words.

Romans 12:15, Rejoice with those who rejoice; mourn with those who mourn.

<u>2 Corinthians 1:3</u>, Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, 4 who comforts us in all our troubles, <u>so</u> that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God.
