Jesus -- Our Example for Reaching Others! Encounter Jesus in the Book of John, Pt. 4 John 4 March 26, 2023

Acts 1:8, But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and <u>Samaria</u>, and to the ends of the earth."

2 Kings 17:5, The king of Assyria invaded the entire land, marched against <u>Samaria</u> and laid siege to it for three years... **24** The <u>king of Assyria brought</u> <u>people from Babylon</u>... and Sepharvaim and settled them in the towns of Samaria to replace the Israelites...

<u>John 4:6, Jacob's well was there</u>, and Jesus, tired as he was from the journey, sat down by the well. It was about noon.

John 4:27, Just then his disciples returned and were surprised to find him talking with a <u>woman</u>... Jesus said, **35**...'It's still four months until harvest'? I tell you, open your eyes and look at the fields! They are ripe for harvest.

How to Reach Others with The Gospel:

1. Talk to People Who Aren't LIKE YOU

John 4:7, When a Samaritan woman came to draw water, Jesus said to her, "Will you give me a drink?" ... **9** The Samaritan woman said to him, "You are a Jew and I am a Samaritan woman. How can you ask me for a drink?"

2. Point Others Toward an Ultimate REALITY

John 4:11, "Sir," the woman said, "you have nothing to draw with and the well is deep.

Where can you get this living water? ...13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, 14 but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

3. Accept People Where THEY ARE

John 4:16, He told her, "Go, call your husband and come back." 17 "I have no husband," she replied. Jesus said to her, "You are right when you say you have no husband. 18 The fact is, you have had five husbands, and the man you now have is not your husband. What you have just said is quite true."

4. Focus Your Conversation on the MAIN THING

John 4:19, "Sir," the woman said, "I can see that you are a prophet. **20** Our ancestors worshiped on this <u>mountain</u>, but you Jews claim that the place where we must worship is in <u>Jerusalem</u>." **21** ...Jesus replied, ... **25** God is spirit, and <u>his worshipers must worship in the Spirit and in truth</u>."

5. Do your Part and Trust God to Do the <u>REST</u>

John 4:30, Many of the <u>Samaritans from that</u> town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, ...

40 So when the Samaritans came to him, they urged him to stay with them, and he stayed two days. **41** And because of his words many more became believers. **42** They said to the woman, "We no longer believe just because of what you said; now we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this man really is the Savior of the world."
