God Speaks IN You! Silent No More: God Still Has Something to Say! Pt. 2 Luke 1:39–56

<u>Luke 1:39</u>, At that time Mary got ready and hurried to a town in the hill country of Judea, **40** where she entered Zechariah's home and greeted Elizabeth.

Psalm 51:10, Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

<u>Jeremiah 31:33</u>, ... "I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people."

Philippians 1:6, being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

<u>Colossians 1:27</u>, To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.

Isaiah 12:2, "Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The LORD, the LORD himself, is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation." **3** With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

Habakkuk 3:17, Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food, though there are no sheep in the pen and no cattle in the stalls, 18 yet I will rejoice in the LORD, I will be joyful in God my Savior.

When God Speaks in You:

1. Joy Becomes VISIBLE

Luke 1:41, When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit. 42 In a loud voice she exclaimed: "Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the child you will bear! 43 But why am I so favored, that the mother of my Lord should come to me? 44 As soon as the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for joy. 45 Blessed is she who has believed that the Lord would fulfill his promises to her!"

Galatians 4:19, My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth until Christ is formed in you,

Romans 15:13, May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Nehemiah 8:10, Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is holy to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."

2. Praise Becomes NATURAL

Luke 1:46, And Mary said: "My soul glorifies the Lord **47** and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,"

<u>Psalm 40:3,</u> He put a new song in my mouth, a hymn of praise to our God. Many will see and fear the LORD and put their trust in him.

Colossians 3:16, Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.

3. Purpose Becomes CLEAR

Luke 1:48, for he has been mindful of the humble state of his servant. From now on all generations will call me

blessed, **49** for the Mighty One has done great things for me—holy is his name.

Ephesians 3:20, Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us,

Philippians 2:13, for it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose.

4. Humility Becomes **ESSENTIAL**

Luke 1:50, His mercy extends to those who fear him, from generation to generation. **51** He has performed mighty deeds with his arm; he has scattered those who are proud in their inmost thoughts. **52** He has brought down rulers from their thrones but has lifted up the humble. **53** He has filled the hungry with good things but has sent the rich away empty.

<u>James 4:6</u>, But he gives us more grace. That is why Scripture says: "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble."

1 Thessalonians 5:16, Rejoice always, 17 pray continually, 18 give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.
