

Count Me In – Gather, Connect and Serve

Acts 2:1-46

September 5 & 6, 2026

Acts 2:1, When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place.

Acts 2:4, All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit...

Acts 2:14, Then Peter stood up with the Eleven, raised his voice and addressed the crowd...

Acts 2:36, ... God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Messiah.

Acts 2:37, When the people heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and the other apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?"

Acts 2:38, Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit."

Acts 2:41, Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

Acts 2:42, They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

1. Gather FAITHFULLY – Because We Are Created to Worship Him Together

Acts 2:46, ... They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts,

1 Thessalonians 5:11, Therefore encourage one another and build each other up...

2. Connect RELATIONALLY – Because Our Faith Flourishes in Community

Acts 2:44, All the believers were together and had everything in common. **45** They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need.

3. Serve WILLINGLY – Because Love Is Expressed Through Action

Acts 2:46, ... They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, **47** praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
