## Run Back to God in Prayer! Run With Purpose! Pt.4 Jonah 1:17-2:10 April 21, 2024

Jonah 1:1, The word of the LORD came to Jonah son of Amittai: 2 "Go to the great city of Nineveh and preach against it, because its wickedness has come up before me." 3 But Jonah ran away from the LORD and headed for Tarshish. He went down to Joppa, where he found a ship bound for that port. After paying the fare, he went aboard and sailed for Tarshish to flee from the LORD.

Jonah 1:17, Now the <u>LORD provided a huge fish</u> to swallow Jonah, and Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights.

<u>Matthew 12:40</u>, For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of a huge fish, so the Son of Man will be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

## **How Do We Run Back to God?**

## 1. RUN to God in the Trial

<u>Jonah 2:1</u>, From <u>inside</u> the fish Jonah prayed to the LORD his God.

Romans 8:28, And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

### 2. KNOW God Hears You Wherever You Are

<u>Jonah 2:2</u>, He said: "In my distress I called to the LORD, and <u>he answered me</u>. From <u>deep</u> in the realm of the dead I called for help, and you <u>listened to my cry</u>. **3** You <u>hurled</u> me into the depths, into the very heart of the seas,

and the currents swirled about me; all your waves and breakers swept over me.

Psalm 139:7, Where can I go from your Spirit? Where can I flee from your presence? 8 If I go up to the heavens, you are there; if I make my bed in the depths, you are there. 9 If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, 10 even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.

### 3. ACKNOWLEDGE the Consequences of Your Actions

Jonah 2:4, I said, 'I have been banished from your sight; yet I will look again toward your holy temple.' 5 The engulfing waters threatened me, the deep surrounded me; seaweed was wrapped around my head. 6 To the roots of the mountains I sank down; the earth beneath barred me in forever...

#### 4. REMEMBER God Still has a Plan for Your Life

<u>Jonah 2:6</u>, ... But you, LORD my God, brought my life up from the pit. 7 "When my life was ebbing away, I <u>remembered</u> you, LORD, and my prayer rose to you, to your holy temple.

Philippians 3:13, Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, 14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

### 5. COMMIT to Obedience Regardless of the Outcome

Jonah 2:8, "Those who cling to <u>worthless idols</u> turn away from God's love for them. 9 But I, with shouts of grateful praise, will sacrifice to you. <u>What I have vowed I will make good</u>. I will say, 'Salvation comes from the LORD.'"

Exodus 20:8, "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

<u>Numbers 15:40</u>, Then you will <u>remember</u> to obey all my commands and will be consecrated to your God.

# 6. EMBRACE Your God-Given Second Chance

<u>Jonah 2:10</u>, And the LORD commanded the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry land.
