1 John 3:10-24
March 14 & 15, 2026

1 John 3:10, *This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are...*

1 John 3:10, ... *Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister. **11** For this is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another.*

John 1:12, *Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God—*

1 John 3:12, *Do not be like Cain, who belonged to the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his own actions were evil and his brother's were righteous.*

Genesis 2:9, ... *In the middle of the garden were the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.*

Genesis 2:16, ... *"You are free to eat from any tree in the garden; **17** but you must not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, for when you eat from it you will certainly die."*

Genesis 3:1, ... *"Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?"*

Genesis 3:9, ... *"Where are you?"*

Genesis 3:15, *"And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your offspring and hers..."*

Genesis 4:3, *In the course of time Cain brought some of the fruits of the soil as an offering to the LORD. **4** And Abel also brought an offering—fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock...*

Genesis 4:4, ... *The LORD looked with favor on Abel and his offering, **5** but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor.*

Hebrews 11:4, *By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did.*

Genesis 4:5, ... *So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast. **6** Then the LORD said to Cain, "Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast?"*

Genesis 4:7, *"If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it."*

Genesis 4:8, *Now Cain said to his brother Abel, "Let's go out to the field." While they were in the field, Cain attacked his brother Abel and killed him.*

Genesis 4:9, *Then the LORD said to Cain, "Where is your brother Abel?" "I don't know," he replied...*

Genesis 4:12, *"When you work the ground, it will no longer yield its crops for you. You will be a restless wanderer on the earth."*

1 John 3:13, Do not be surprised, my brothers and sisters, if the world hates you.

Romans 1:16, For I am not ashamed of the gospel...

1 John 3:16, This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

1 John 3:18, Dear children, let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

1 John 3:19, This is how we know that we belong to the truth and how we set our hearts at rest in his presence: **20** If our hearts condemn us, we know that God is greater than our hearts, and he knows everything.

Romans 8:1, Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus,

1 John 3:21, Dear friends, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence before God **22** and receive from him anything we ask, because we keep his commands and do what pleases him.

1 John 3:24, The one who keeps God's commands lives in him, and he in them. And this is how we know that he lives in us: We know it by the Spirit he gave us.
